The Port of Edmonds is seeking applicants for the Commission At Large position which will be available on March 31, 2025.

Position: At Large

Eligibility Requirements: Applicants "eligible" to fill the commission vacancy are those who are

- 1. Are a resident of the Port District; and
- 2. Registered to vote within the Port District (map attached)

Timeline:

- 1. Application period: February 26 March 12
- 2. Potential interviews: March 24 March 28
- 3. Vacancy occurs: March 30
- 4. Commission announces its nominee(s): March 31
- 5. Notice period to public of nominee(s): April 1 15
- 6. Potential interviews: April 21 April 25
- 7. Commission expects to vote to approve candidate to fill vacancy: April 28
